

In order to obtain a Land Disturbing Permit you must have the following:

Industrial, Commercial and Assembly Type Development

- 1. Completed Land Disturbing Application.**
- 2. 4 Sets of Engineered Site Plans.**
- 3. 2 Sets of Drainage Reports.**
- 4. Copy of the Submitted Notice of Intent. (if applicable)**
- 5. Wetland delineation approval. (if applicable)**
- 6. Copy of the tax paid receipt for the property.**
- 7. Copy of the ES & PC checklist**
- 8. Copy of Environmental Health approval. (if applicable)**
- 9. Liberty County permit fees checklist.**
- 10. Payment for all applicable fees.**

Property must be zoned for the use: I-1 for Industrial, B-2 for Commercial, A-1 or AR-1 for Churches or O-1 for Offices. Property must be identified and inspected prior to issuing of a permit for compliance with zoning regulations.

Before any land clearing can be done we must have all approvals from the following in order to issue an LDA permit. Environmental Health, County Engineer. Site work must be in place and approved by the Director of the Liberty County Building & Licensing Department before a final inspection and C. O. can be issued.

The following bonds may be required. The bonds must be filed with the Liberty County Building and Licensing Department before a Certificate of Occupancy is issued.

Performance Bond for Landscaping and/or Tree must be valid for Two years.

Maintenance Bond must be valid for One year.

Depending on the type of activity to be placed on the property other requirements may surface. Some activities require state certifications or licenses.

Please submit all of the information requested for the permit to be issued.
